Solo Endorsements

As you are aware, UFS policy requires that a student receive three supervised solos. This procedure ensures that a student is ready for a student solo each time and places a level of check and balance in each solo flight. For each solo the instructor will fly with the student first and if the student is ready for each additional solo after the dual flight, the instructor will allow the student to solo. This will require three endorsements, one for each solo.

Your endorsement should be good for only one day and should not be an open endorsement in order to ensure compliance with UFS procedures outlined in the student pilot handbook.

Please review the renter's agreement and the UFS handbook and make sure that each of your students has a renter's agreement on file along with a signed copy of the last page of the UFS Student Handbook.

Endorsement example:

I certify that (name of student) has received the required training of 61.93(b)(1). I have determined that he / she is proficient to practice solo takeoffs and landings at (KDWH). The takeoffs and landings at (KDWH) are subject to the following conditions:
Temperature and dew point spread ≥ 5 degrees, crosswinds < 5 knots, visibility > 5 miles. This endorsement is good for this date only.
